NextWindow multi-touch technology comes to life in Dell's Studio One 19 desktop

NextWindow has been developing touch screen technology for nearly 10 years. NextWindow began selling into the PC market in 2007. Its first customer was HP, whose TouchSmart all-in-one PC now uses NextWindow touch screens.
